## **About the Neighbourhood Rain Murals**

Neighbourhood Rain Murals is the final project of the #RichmondHasHeart initiative that was launched during the pandemic to reconnect residents with each other and public spaces in creative ways.

In Spring 2022, community members were invited to submit written ideas or original drawings highlighting the unique attributes of their neighbourhood. A selection panel reviewed all graphic submissions and selected a series of designs per neighbourhood. Four professional local artists, Jeni Chen, Dawn Lo, Keely O'Brien and Lisa Taniguchi, used the written submissions as inspiration to create a unique design for each of the eight neighbourhoods surrounding Richmond's community centres (Cambie/East Richmond, City Centre, Hamilton, Sea Island, South Arm, Steveston, Thompson and West Richmond).

For the final phase of this project, each neighbourhood has six original designs stencilled onto sidewalks and public plazas. Using an eco-friendly hydrophobic paint, the designs are only visible after it rains.
